Free School Meals

Could your child be entitled to free school meals (FSM)? Did you know that our schools receives additional funding for every child who entitled to free school meals. This money could be used for any of the following:

- Providing additional academic support for FSM children who need to boost progress or be challenged further
- Providing financial support towards additional costs of education such as trips
- Providing financial support to allow every FSM child one free (normally paid for) extra-curricular activity after school per week for the whole year.
- Providing financial support towards uniform and equipment
- Additional Educational needs resources

Who can get free school meals?

All pupils in Reception, Year One or Year Two are entitled to 'universal' free school meals. **This is not the same as 'Free School Meals' (FSM).** Pupils that are eligible for free school meals receive additional funding called '**Pupil Premium.**'

You may be eligible for free school meals if you get:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR)
- Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance (IB-JSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit and are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and your annual income, as assessed by the Inland Revenue, does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run on'- the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax CreditUniversal Credit

Online Safety - Helpful information for parents.

Childnet have updated their parent and carer toolkit to help parents have conversations about online safety. Their booklet 'Let's talk about life online' includes ten key messages that should be shared with children:

1. You can always come to me if you need help.
2. What would you do if this happened...?
3. Remember that not everyone is who they say they are online.
4. Keep your personal information safe, and other people's too.
5. Be respectful to others online.
6. Think before you post.
7. Remember to ask if it's okay.
8. Remember not everything is true online.
9. The things other people post online might not always show what their life is really like.
10. Recognise how going online makes you feel and take a break when you need to.
