Hedgehogs Bubble – Mr Wilson and Mrs Knight

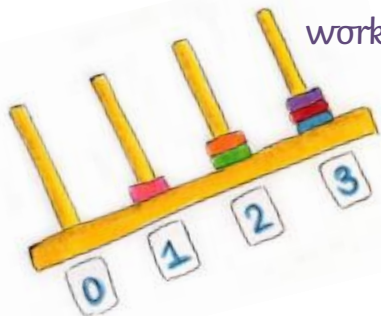

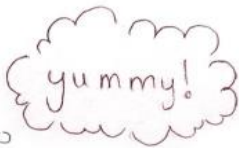

Being clean is extra important at the moment so we can keep everyone healthy. We are going to be super cleaners.



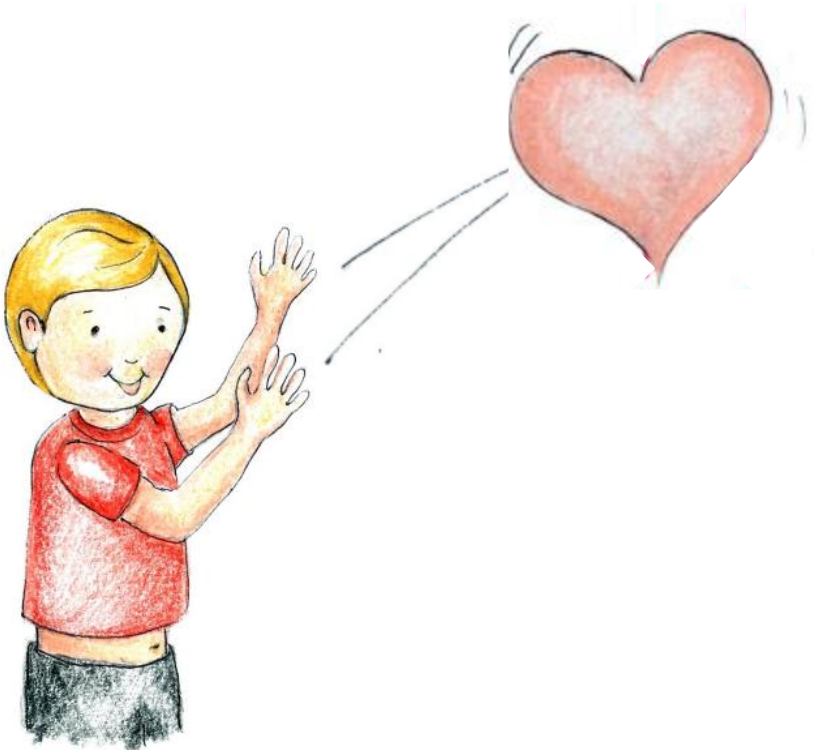
