## Star of the Week Awards

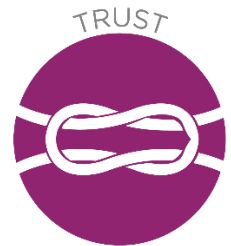
Otters (Reception) ~ Eoin for his fantastic blending using Fred talk.
