Dear Parents,

On Monday, we received the phone call the most head teachers, including myself, dread – OFSTED. The inspection was completed over the next two days. We are unable to share the findings with you until they have gone through their quality assurance procedures. This can take up to thirty working days. As soon as we are able to do so, I will share the report with you.

I would like to personally thank you all for the support you provided us with over the two days. Your chocolates, doughnuts and kind words of reassurance kept us going throughout – thank you.

Thursday night saw the first of our PTA events for this year. The children thoroughly enjoyed watching the films whilst enjoying a hotdog and some popcorn. The event raised £185. This year, the funds raised by the PTA will be used to pay for the cost of the coaches for our two residentials, £250 for each class for WOW starters and some VR headsets which will be used to enhance the children’s learning experiences. I have added some additional dates to our calendar – cake sale, Christmas Fair, Sponsored Pancake Flip and Summer Fair.

Next Tuesday, Squirrels Class will be going to the Anderton Boat Lift where they will be learning about how canals work, and the impact they’ve had on our lives. Our Harvest Festival is on Friday at St Leonard’s Church. Each year, we ask the children to bring in some food which we donate to Pauls Pantry in Crewe. There are more details later in the newsletter. We will be leaving school at 9:30am if you would like to join us for the service. There are also two further services which our families are invited to: Harvest Thanksgiving on Friday night at 7pm and the Harvest Family Service on Sunday morning at 11:30am.

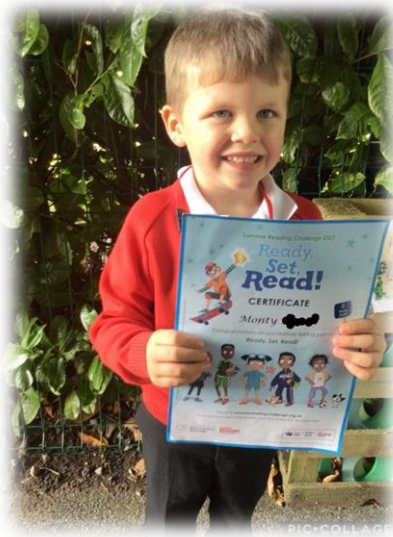


