Dear Parents,

On Wednesday all the primary schools in our local area hosted a well-being day for the children in their schools. Anxiety and worry are normal everyday feelings which we will all experience from time to time. What is important is we recognise these feelings and know what we can do to help ourselves when we are finding things hard.

Each of the activities planned was linked to a picture book and used to help the children to explore their feelings and worries. The children were also provided with various techniques they could use to help them when they are feeling anxious. We also arranged some taster yoga sessions for the children which they thoroughly enjoyed – they were very sleepy afterwards! We will be running a yoga club after half term. Information has been sent home with the children in Otters and Squirrels. If there is room available, we will open this club up to the children in Squirrels and Badgers. As a school, every child starts the afternoon with a mindfulness activity. These only last about 5 minutes, but really help the children to regulate their feelings so they are in a good place to learn. This is something we have been doing for a long time and has had a real impact on the children's emotional well-being.

On Tuesday night, our PTA meet to arrange lots of exciting events for you to enjoy whilst also raising money for the school. They have some exciting events planned, including a Pamper and Fizz Night for us Mums, a Spooky Disco and Film Night for the children. Your donations really do make a huge difference.


