Understanding of the World: As scientists, we will grow our own fruits and vegetables. Will we learn about where our vegetables come from? We will observe a variety of vegetables frozen in ice – noticing and explaining the changes that happen. As geographers, we will look at the different countries our fruit and vegetables come from comparing the different climate and conditions needed for growth.

Communication and Language: We will continue our weekly show and tell sessions and explain how things work. We will role play the story of Supertato and create our own superhero stories using puppets and key vocabulary from the story.

Maths:
