Dear Parents and Carers,

Attached to this letter are your child/ren's logins for Times Table Rockstars and Mathletics. As per our procedure these online tools will support our mathematics homework moving forwards and the first homework task has been set this week.

On a weekly basis children will be set homework to complete using these online platforms. Class Teachers have already demonstrated to your children how to log in and how to access their weekly homework.

Homework will be set in term time on a Monday to be completed by the following Monday. Mathletics homework will be based on the topics children are currently learning in school whilst times tables will be set at an age appropriate level. It is asked that children spend at least 15 minutes on Times Table Rockstars each week. This means that the objectives will be relevant and reinforce current learning. Teachers will be able to access live results as children complete their homework and this assessment information will support teachers with tracking progress over time.

If any children are struggling to access or complete their homework, Mrs Killilea will be running a homework club on a Thursday lunchtime from 12.30 - 1.00pm, starting from this week. This will allow children to use school lap tops to complete homework tasks. It will be the responsibility of the children to attend the club on the day.

We appreciate that this is a significant change to our approach to mathematics homework so we will support children/parents during this process. Our Meet the Teacher sessions on Thursday  $17^{th}$  October will support any parents wishing to have a live demonstration of the process. Timings for these are as follows – Years 1 and 2 (3.15 – 3.30pm), Years 3 and 4 (3.30 – 3.45pm) and Years 5 and 6 (3.45 – 4.00pm).
