Warmingham Pupils to Represent Our School at CDAT Climate Conference



We're incredibly proud to announce that Rogan, Emily, and Oscar have been selected to represent Warmingham at the upcoming CDAT Climate Conference next Thursday, 3rd July. This is a fantastic opportunity for our Year 5 pupils to take part in a special event focused on Climate Action, coinciding with the launch of the Trust's Climate Action Plan.

The half-day conference will bring together pupils and staff from across the Trust to explore how we can all play a part in caring for our planet. The day will begin with an inspiring keynote from environmental campaigner Laura Young (also known as Less Waste Laura), followed by a series of hands-on workshops led by the Archbishop's Young Leaders Award team and Let's Go Zero.

Our representatives will learn about the causes and effects of climate change, discover practical ways to make a difference, and reflect on the Christian responsibility of looking after God's creation. The event is designed to empower pupils to become Climate Ambassadors - or 'Changemakers' - who will continue to lead environmental initiatives in school as they move into Year 6 with Mrs Bugliarello's support.

We're excited to see the ideas and inspiration Rogan, Emily, and Oscar will bring back to Warmingham!
