COVID-19 Update

We are now coming to the end of our two-week period of additional COVID-19 measures. As we still have a couple of cases within school, it would be wise to continue these measures until the end of term to protect the children, staff and our families especially as the R Rate remains high around Sandbach and the surrounding areas.

Until the end of term:

- The children will remain in their bubbles, with separate play and lunchtimes
- There will be no after school clubs – Mad Science will be rearranged for after Christmas
- Worship will continue online.
- Staff will continue to take daily LFT tests
- Any staff who have been in close contact with a child or adult who has tested positive will take PCR test
- Staff will continue to wear masks in communal areas.
- All meetings with parents will be via zoom.
- Only essential visitors will be allowed into school.
- Visitors will need to take a LFT test before coming, and wear a mask throughout their visit.

I can understand and sympathise that this is a very worrying time, particularly that this is the first time COVID has really been seen in such larger numbers within school. I will continue to monitor the situation very closely and seek advice from public health as needed.

The government guidance is clear in that there is an expectation that all children should attend school unless they are:

- **symptomatic and awaiting the outcome of a PCR result**
- **positive from a LFD or PCR test**
- **a child within a household where there is a positive case (5 days self-isolation)**

As a result, I am unable to authorise any absences for children whose parents have made the decision to keep their children at home. This obviously leaves all head teachers in a difficult situation as we are acutely aware of parents' worries. However, we are doing everything we can in school to reduce the spread of the virus within school and will continue to work with public health and the local authority if our numbers rise again.

What should I do if my child has symptoms?

1. Complete a LFT test
2. If the result is positive book a PCR test to confirm
3. Inform the school – using both of the following emails – principalwarmingham@rcsat.cheshire.sch.uk and admin@warminghce.cheshire.sch.uk

What we will do if a positive PCR is confirmed:

1. Inform all parents that we have a positive COVID case with school
2. For the relevant bubble, we will ask parents to take their child for a PCR test. If any of the children come back positive, we will ask parents to complete a LFT test with their child on day 1, day 5 and day 8.
8. This is to ensure any asymptomatic cases in school are identified quickly.

Please note - If your child has tested positive for COVID-19, they should not be tested using either PCR or rapid lateral flow tests for 90 days, unless they develop new symptoms – in which case they should be retested immediately using PCR.

Christmas Arrangements

Despite the unsettled climate we live in, we are determined to ensure that we celebrate this most special time of year whilst still ensuring that we keep everyone as safe as possible. With this in mind, we will be putting in the following measures to ensure the safety of the children, staff and our families so we can allow parents to watch our Nativity and join our Carol Service. **Tickets for these events will be available to book from 6pm on Monday 29th November via the School Spider App.**

- There will be two performances for Otters and Hedgehog's 'The Big Little Nativity'
- Tickets will be limited to **two per family** to ensure social distancing. I know that some family members will be disappointed as they will not be able to come. I'm sure you'll appreciate why this is so important at this time
- Adults will need to complete a LFT test before coming
- Adults will NOT be able to attend if they have any COVID symptoms
- Adults will need to sanitise their hands as they enter
- Adults will need to wear a mask throughout the performance

As with everything over the past 2 years, we will have a contingency plan in place so that parents and children do not miss out in anyway.

Wednesday 1st December @ 10am – Christingle Service

Wednesday 8th & Thursday 9th December - Otters & Hedgehogs' 'The Big Little Nativity'

This year we are planning to hold our performances 'live' in the village hall. To aid with social distancing and reduced numbers in an enclosed area, we are limiting tickets to two per family. Adults will need to complete a LFT test before coming and wear a mask throughout the performance. Please do NOT come if you have any COVID symptoms.

Contingency Plan – we will be filming one of the dress rehearsal, which we will stream live on the days of the performance. We will also be making this film available to those who were unable to come via zoom.

14th December – Christmas Jumper Day & Christmas Lunch (order lunch via School Spider App)


