Getting Ready for September

As we look ahead to the new school year, here are a few helpful reminders so that everyone is ready for a smooth start.



Uniform

Our full uniform list can be found on the school website. Just a quick reminder:

- Blazers are optional and only for children in Key Stage 2
- Please no rucksacks, as we don't have space to store them
- Children need a bookbag and a drawstring PE bag



Water Bottles

Each child will also need a reusable water bottle (between 500ml and 1 litre). **It's important that the children can hold it in their hands.**

We have water fountains in school that provide fresh, chilled water. Children are encouraged to finish their bottle by lunchtime and refill it for the afternoon. Bottles will be sent home each day to be washed and ready to go again the next morning.



Pencil Cases (Squirrels & Badgers only)

Children in Key Stage 2 will need a small pencil case containing:

- A couple of HB pencils
- A small ruler
- Two different coloured highlighters
- A sharpener with a container for the shavings
- A glue stick
- An eraser



We'll provide each child with:

- A pair of scissors
- Handwriting pens and their green for growth pens
- Colouring pencils and felt tips

Pencil cases will come home every Friday so families can top up any bits that have been used.

Stay Safe this Summer

Whether you're staying at home or going on holiday this summer, make sure you are being safe in and around the water.

What to do if you see someone in trouble

Shout – "Are you in trouble? Can you swim towards me, or stand up?"

Reach – find a long object that you can let go of, to try and reach the person. Lie down or crouch so you aren't pulled in too.

Throw – throw something to help keep them afloat - throwlines (floating lines), footballs, and life rings are great options.

Don't go – Never go into the water yourself; keep eyes on them and call 999 immediately.

If you're in trouble, Float to Live - lie on your back, keeping your mouth above the surface, and try to gently move to safety. Stay calm.
