

### **Inference Questions**

- What do you think...means? Why do you think that?
- Why do you think...?
- How do you think...?
- When do you think...?
- Where do you think...?
- How has the author made us think that...?

### **Retrieval Questions**

- Who is/are the main character(s)?
- When/where is the story set?
- Which is your favourite/worst/funniest/scariest part of the story? Why?
- Tell me three facts you have learnt from the text.
- Find the part where...

### **Vocabulary Questions**

- Can you find a word/sentence that tells/shows you that...
- Why do you think that the author used the word... to describe...?
- Can you find a word in the text that means the same as...?
- Find an adjective in the text.



### **If you can't read a word, say:**

- Can you break it up?
- Are there any sounds you know?
- Do you know a word that looks like it?
- What could it say?
- Does the picture help?
- Do you recognise any words within it?
- Read to the end of the sentence and think about what words that might fit.

### **Sequencing questions**

- What happens in the beginning of the story?
- How/where does the story start?
- What happened at the end of the...?
- Can you re-tell the story to me in 20 words or less?
- What happened before that?

### **Prediction questions**

- Where do you think... will go next?
- What do you think...will say/do next?
- What do you think this book will be about and why?
- What do you think will happen in this chapter?
- How do you think this will end?
- Who do you think has done it?
- What might...say about that?
