Willow – Blue

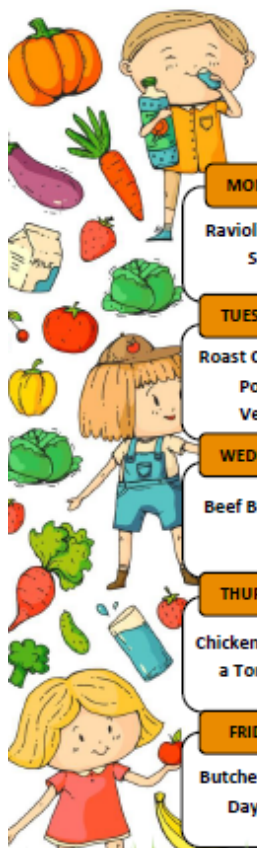


STAR Day - Thursday 14th July
