Free School Meals

Have you checked to see if your child is eligible for free school meals? Even if your child is in Otters' or Hedgehogs' Class, it's worth applying as the school receives additional funding known as pupil premium to support your child in lots of different ways, such as paying for trips, music lessons and after school clubs.

Children in Otters' and Hedgehogs' Class are able to have universal school meals which are funded by the government. These are not the same as free school meals and we do not receive the additional pupil premium funding.
